Upon successful completion, participants will receive 9/10 ECTS credit points.

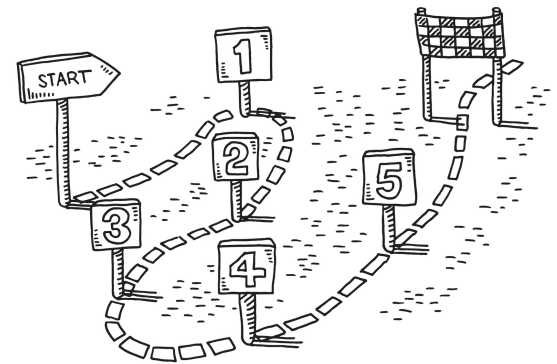
The following elements are part of the seminar assessment:

paper should relate to one of these

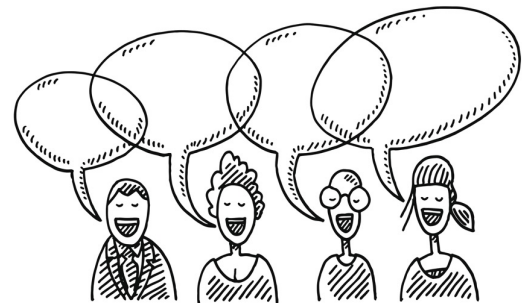

- Presentation topics: Your ideas for your term paper
- Duration: 5 minutes, present
 - Key elements of your paper
 - Rough question, additional reading you might consult
 - Preliminary structure
 - Not more than 2 PPP slides
- Focus on the important **key elements**

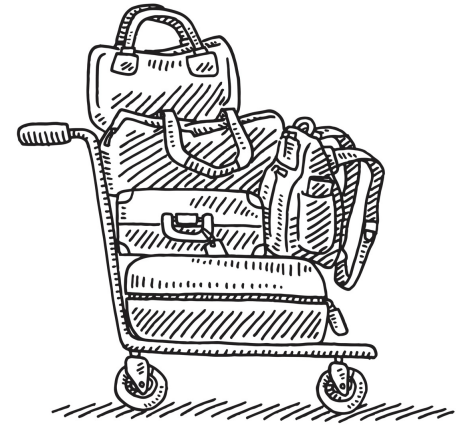

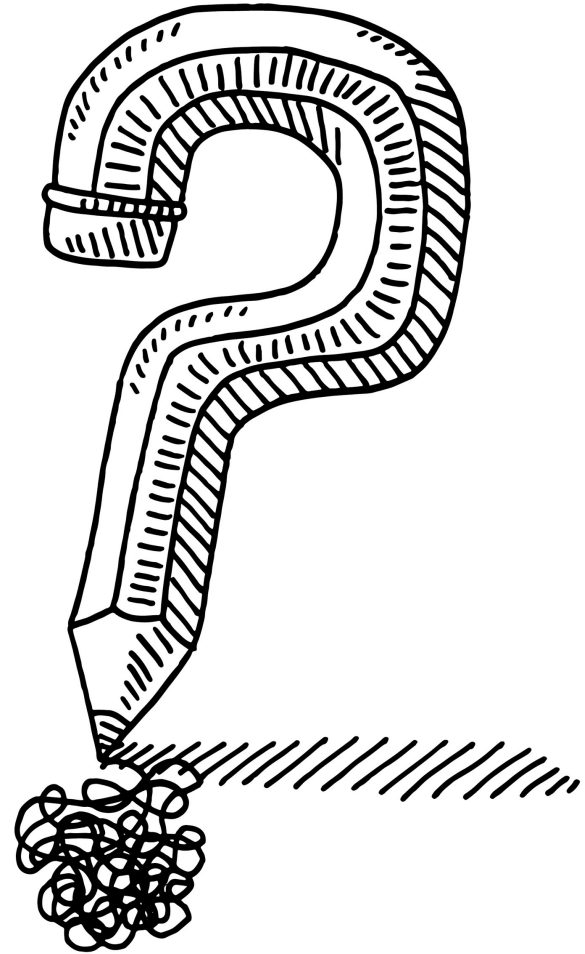

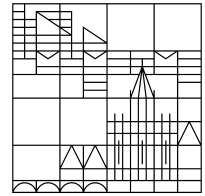
