<b>Accommodation</b>		
<i>A. Accommodation in CROUS Student residence</i>		
Student residences are managed by the CROUS (Students’ social services): (a) city centre campus: flat-share studios for 2, no separate bedroom, basic equipment. (b) campus Agroparc: individual studios. <i>C. Independent housing in the private sector</i>

<i>NB: All students from the European Economic Area or holding a residence permit or a long stay visa and in possession of a rent receipt (“bail de location”) can apply for students’ housing benefit.</i>		
<b>Health insurance requirements</b>		

- Students from the European Union holding a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or a private insurance certificate have a basic health cover.
- Students from outside the EU and not holding an EHIC must subscribe a compulsory students' basic health cover ("Sécurité sociale") upon enrolment at the University. This free of charge insurance offers partial refunding of current health expenses (70% on average). <https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/>
- An additional health cover ("*mutuelle*") is strongly recommended. This "*mutuelle*" can cover medical expenses that are not covered by the basic health insurance, "*Sécurité Sociale*".
- All students must take out a repatriation insurance in their home country before they arrive in France.

#### **Choice of lectures and learning agreement**

Exchange students are entitled to select lectures from different Departments (UFR-ip) and from different years within their undergraduate Degree or Masters Programme. Each student is required to take a full semester programme (30 ECTS credits). Students needing less than 27 ECTS credits for their home University should produce an exemption letter from the ERASMUS pedagogical coordinator. Masters students are welcome to select lectures from undergraduate programmes.
