



Academic year, study periods

- academic year overview: Link
- winter semester 2024/2025 study period: 1 October 2024 31 March 2025
- lecture period: 21 October 2024 08 February 2025
- lecture-free period around Christmas and New Year's: 21 December 2024 06 January 2025
- exam period: last two weeks of the lecture period (plus: eventually first week of lecture-free period)

Course types

- lectures with homework assignments and tutorials (Mathematics, Physics, Biology)
 - teaching in large groups
 - tutorials provide a platform for discussions of exercises
- seminars (Mathematics, Psychology, Biology)
 - student-centred teaching in smaller groups
- courses with practical parts (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
 - self-directed lab work
- Important! Attendance in courses might be mandatory except from lectures.





- course registration is only possible after ZEuS log-in with university ID
- course registration period: starts approximately on 1 September or 1 October 2024 and lasts at least for four weeks
- course registration in ZEuS is important to have access to the respective course in the online learning platform Ilias
- Important! Registration for practical courses may have other periods and procedures!


Interdisciplinary course selection


- in principle possible to take courses from other departments
- Important! There are departmental-specific regulations and some exceptions regarding seminars.
- carefully read through prerequisites for the course in ZEuS
- if interested, contact the lecturer and ask whether it is possible to participate
- in case of a positive answer, normal course registration via ZEuS
- with technical problems, contact your <u>Departmental Erasmus+ Coordinator</u> or the <u>Departmental Examination Office</u>

- examination registration period: starts approximately on 1 November 2024 or later and lasts at least for four weeks
- <u>Important!</u> Examination registration periods differ between the departments within the Faculty of Sciences.
- <u>Important!</u> Examination registration via ZEuS is <u>obligatory</u> for <u>all</u> study achievements for which you want to gain ECTS.
- when technical problems arise with the registration contact the Departmental Examination Office





The Language Institute (SLI)

- responsible for all practical language courses
- for international students there are German language courses at basic, intermediate and advanced level
- registration is possible after language placement test of the SLI
- **Important!** Registration is not possible in advance or online.



Interdisciplinary course offers

Universität Konstanz

The Centre for Transferable Skills

- offers courses to gather interdisciplinary qualifications e.g. academic writing, giving an oral presentation, ...
- current courses are listed in the <u>course catalogue in ZEuS</u>, also <u>Courses Taught in English</u> under the branch Transferable
 Skills
- Important! Registration in advance in ZEuS is needed.
- **Important!** Registration to the course means automatic registration for the exam.
- if you do not want to take part it is <u>obligatory to deregister</u> from the course

Extension of your stay

Extension is possible from the winter semester 2024/25 into the summer semester 2025

- application deadline: 1 December 2024 (exceptions are not possible)
- it is not guaranteed to live in a Seezeit student accommodation in the extended period
- written permission from the International Office of your <u>home university</u> is needed
- Departmental Erasmus+ Coordinator at the <u>University of Konstanz</u> has to accept the extension
- all signed documents have to be submitted at the International Office of the <u>University of Konstanz</u>


Continuation of your studies in the following semester

- it must be <u>stated explicitly</u> if you wish to continue your admitted studies
- this is done by paying the semester fees
- deadline for the proximate summer semester (2025): 15 January 2025 15 February 2025

Student ID card





- functions: pay at food vending points (cafeteria, Campus Café, etc.), locks and unlocks library lockers on B4 and N6, place
 on the backside for StudiTicket, library card, student discount at some cultural organisations
- used for <u>Canon print service</u>: log in with university's email address and password and get access to print jobs and credit
- different loading terminals for the Mensa and the library copy machines
- Important! Semester sticker of the actual semester has to be affixed on the backside.
