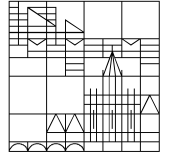

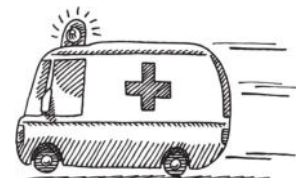

What is discrimination?

Discrimination is any form of devaluation, disadvantage or unequal treatment of individuals or groups on the basis of various perceptible or ascribed characteristics that are not directly perceptible.

If you'd like to learn more, should you experience antidiscrimination and/or would like to report an incident, please contact antidiskriminierung@uni-konstanz.de.

Sexual discrimination describes the disparagement of and discrimination against others based on their gender. **Sexual harassment** relates to verbal and physical abuse of another person. **Sexualised violence** includes criminal acts such as coercion and rape. **Stalking** was added to the German criminal code in 2007. It is regarded as an alternative form of harassment and constitutes a criminal offence. You are being stalked if another person intentionally and repeatedly follows and harasses you, thereby threatening your safety and severely impeding your ability to live a normal life.

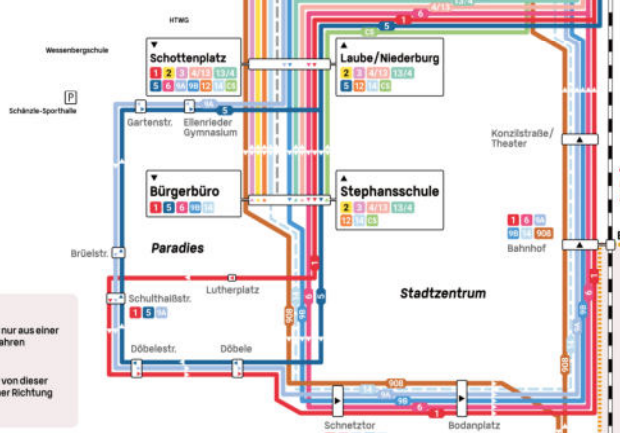

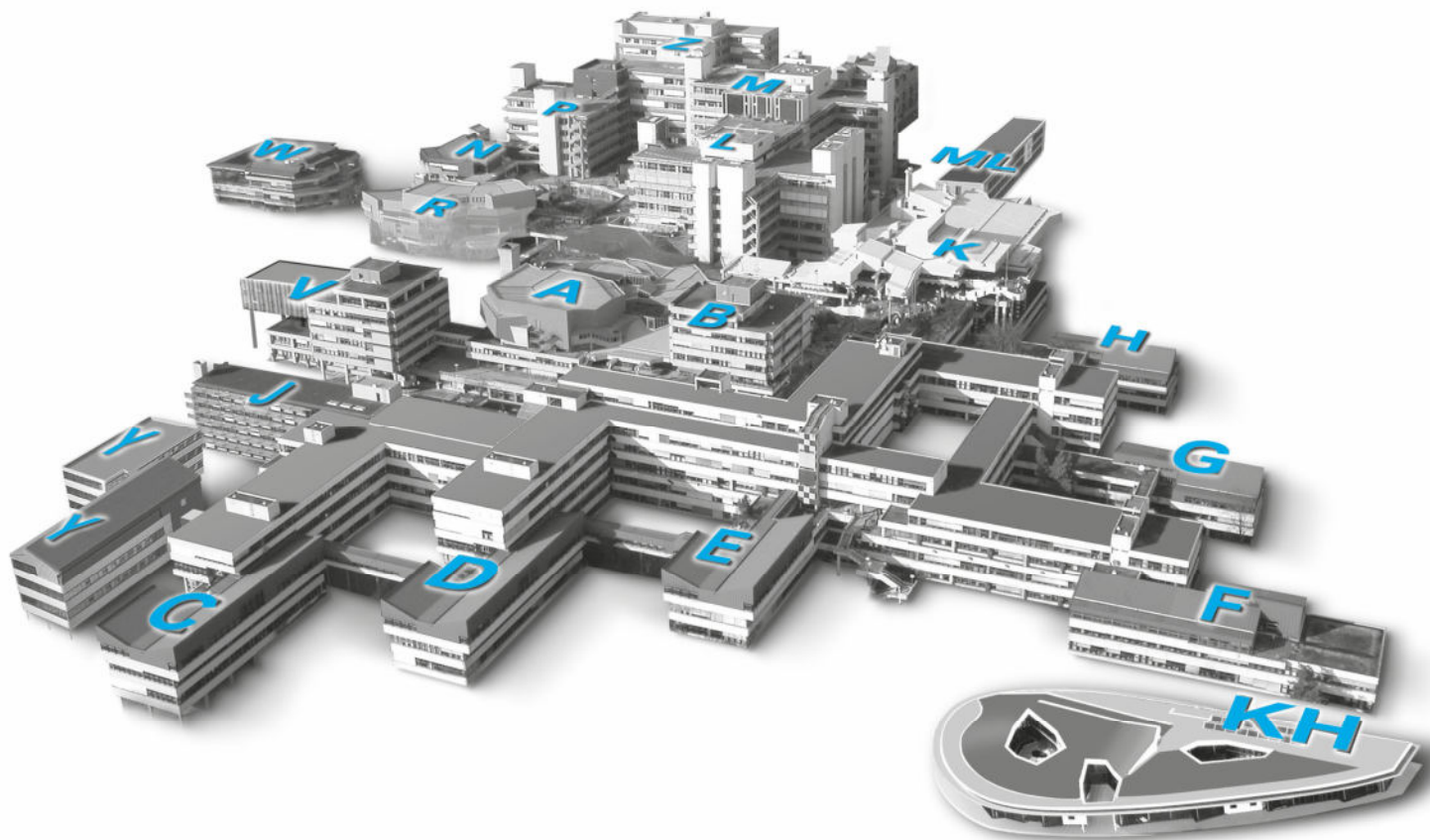
