



1. Take a biometrical photo

Only one physical biometrical photo (not photo file) is needed to apply for a residence permit for study purposes.



You can conveniently take them in the Fotofix photo booths scattered through town. Please find the locations of the Fotofix photo booths in town on the map on **page 14**

2. Upload remaining documents to Mobility Online

Be it the entry stamp in your passport (only non-EU/EEA students without visa obligation), the confirmation of landlord/landlady that you moved in accommodation (Wohnungsgeberbestätigung) when <u>not living in a Seezeit student residence</u>, the proof of financial resources (only for non-EU/EEA students without long-term visa), or new EHIC card, etc.

Studiticket


The **Studiticket** is a ticket only for students, that allows them to travel within the municipality by public bus, by train (only from train station Wollmatingen to Konstanz main train station) and with the car ferry (no other ferries) Konstanz/Staad ↔ Meersburg, including the bike for free.

You can purchase the Studiticket (65,30 EUR; valid for one semester) either as a label for the UniCard (attach on back side) or as e-ticket with the "Mein Konstanz" app.


Note: There are two different higher educational institutions in Konstanz, the University of Konstanz and the HTWG-University of Applied Sciences, with each having their own but different Studiticket.

Good to know: You can also use the buses within the municipality only with your UniCard and current semester label **without** the Studiticket, but only in the evenings from 19.00 h (and not the night busses).

As a student of the University of Konstanz, please make sure to purchase the **green label** (not pink). For the ticket to be valid to use, you must have your UniCard and the current semester label (and Studiticket must be attached on back of UniCard). The ticket alone is not valid! Please observe the selling points in town on the map on page 14.






